	 Bill 23: There will be an Umbrella Act for the 22 professional organizations 	
	under Alberta Labour and Immigration. This includes one act, one set of	
	regulations, and individualized schedules.	
	 Bill was not passed before writ was dropped. 	
	 Expected ACPA actions are to develop new bylaws to align with the Act and 	
	Regulations in 2023/2024	



- Labour Mobility Act came into effect April 6, 2023: which applies to "labour mobility applicants."
- Must acknowledge application within 10 days and make a decision within 20 days.
- We will update the website as the registration process is required.
- o **The Fair Registration Practices Act** is meant to ensure the assessment process is fair, impartial, and objective.
- We are required to report on a yearly basis. More record keeping is required.

- Increase in Professional Dues

- There will be small increase in annual dues for P.Chem members from \$295.00 to \$325.00 to offset anticipated legal and training expenses for the new legislation.
- o Dues for CIT members and Non-Practicing members to remain the same.
- o Increase is required to help offset costs.
