As the Executive Director - Alberta Radiopharmaceutical services, you will be responsible and accountable in the development, implementation and management of ARS, with significant, province-wide impact. The Executive Director holds accountability for the overall direction, performance and results achieved by the program area, while ensuring overall compliance with regulatory body requirements. You will develop, implement, and evaluate short-term and long-term strategies including pricing of products, process development, quality assurance, research and development associated with clinical and preclinical radiopharmaceuticals in alignment with AHS priorities, values and organizational goals. A key success to this role will be building, nurturing and facilitating collaborative relationships necessary for effective and long-term engagement with diverse internal and external stakeholders and vendors, including a substantial and comprehensive team of leaders across the entire organization.
